Dear Rising Third Grade Families,

Happy end of the school year! We are so excited to welcome you and your child to third grade! Next year, Mrs. Connell will be teaching ELA and Social Studies, while Mrs. Clarke will be teaching Math and Science. Today, we had the pleasure of meeting your children during our annual Move-Up Day. Each child received a summer homework bag along with information about the required pages to complete in the Module 5 Math Book and the summer reading assignment, *The Chocolate Touch*, including the accompanying activity packet. Both of these summer requirements will be given a grade, please help your child complete these assignments. To help your child feel confident and prepared for third grade, we ask that they complete the following summer learning activities:

Math:

- Practice addition, subtraction, and multiplication flashcards regularly.
- Complete the required pages in the Module 5 Math Book. (The pages stapled to the front cover are required; the remaining pages are optional.)
- Students attending summer school will work on the module during class.
- Continue working on Happy Numbers activities through the second-grade level.

ELA:

- Read, read, read!
- The required summer reading book for incoming third graders is *The Chocolate Touch*. Students should complete the accompanying activity booklet as they read.
- Encourage your child to continue writing over the summer, perhaps by keeping a journal about summer activities and trips. Please focus on writing 2-3 complete sentences using proper spelling and punctuation.
- If possible, practice the 3rd Grade "Red Words" Spelling List to assist your child in their spelling skills.

We hope you and your family enjoy a relaxing and joyful summer. We are looking forward to an amazing year together in third grade!
