Saint Francis Xavier School is pleased to offer a full day summer camp program for preschool through 8th grade students again this year! Classes are designed to help students complete their summer homework, reinforce grade level skills, and provide enrichment and exploratory opportunities. Classes that have been designed for students to COMPLETE their summer homework are noted. If your child participates in one of these classes for the full three weeks they will leave on the last day ready for the first day of school in August!

12:00 – 3:00 Lunch/Recess/Afternoon Camp
3:00 – 5:00 After Care

Academic Program Fees – Morning Classes:

3 Weeks: \$500.00
Sibling Discount: \$450.00 for each additional child

Camp Fees – Lunch/Afternoon Camp:

3 Weeks: \$375.00
Sibling Discount: \$325.00 for each additional child

After Care Fee:

\$20 per day per child (due at the end of each week)

Registration Fees: (Per Family)

May 16th – May 25th: Late Registration (\$75 Fee)

Snack and Lunch Information:

The snack bar will be open from 10-10:30 every day and students will be brought to the snack bar by their teacher. Extra Fee applies (students may also bring a snack from home).

Welcome to three weeks of fun -filled learning! Each week we will introduce an exciting new theme that will integrate math, reading and writing skills using a hands-on approach. If your child is entering Second Grade...
