- 1. Write the title of the book and its author.
- 2. Setting. Write 2 sentences describing where and when the story takes place.
- **Questions 3-7 should all be answered using at least 3-4 sentences.**
- 3. Major character. Using 3-4 sentences, describe the main character. For example: What do they look like, what is their personality like?
- 4. Minor character. Using 3-4 sentences, describe a minor, or less important, character in the story.
- 5. Plot. Summarize the story. Write 3-4 sentences telling what the story is about, and include the main conflict, or problem in the story. You do not need to rewrite the story, just give main points.
- 6. Resolution. How does the main conflict resolve or end?
- 7. Your thoughts. Describe your favorite scene from the story. Why did you like this scene?
