Below is a list of significant events that are on the calendar between 3/16 - 3/29 and an update on each.

Sacraments of Initiation Retreat 3/20 (3rd grade):

In order to comply with the CDC and federal guidelines for large gatherings, the retreat is cancelled. Mrs. Westerfield is working on a plan to make sure students receive the formation from the retreat. Information and student/parent activities from the retreat will be shared through the third grade teachers Google Classroom account. Older students who are working with Mrs. Westerfield on their sacraments will receive an email from her with the information.

Eighth Grade Retreat 3/26 at the CASA:

In order to comply with the CDC and federal guidelines for large gatherings, the eighth grade retreat is cancelled. The unique format and experiential nature of this retreat makes it difficult to replicate using DLP, but Mrs. Westerfield will collaborate with Ms. Falcon and share information through the 8th grade religion Google Classroom account.
