Nurses – Barb/Susie

1. Teachers will not be quarantined if there is a positive in the class due to the limitations on contact.
2. MC informed the nurses how to proceed - Quarantined kids had contacts that were identified so they were told to quarantine. Sibling classes did not have a positive contact so were not required to quarantine.
3. If a student is quarantined, can they come back to school with showing a negative test? No, because positive could develop later. Per the CDD/Health Department the quarantine period deals with this issue and that is why a negative test cannot be substituted for quarantine.
4. Legally, we cannot require a negative test to return. After positive test, 10 days of no quarantine with no symptoms to come back.
5. Parents requested to help keep our SFX community safe by being safe out in the community.
6. Medical study on low transmission if follow social distance, mask, and hand washing.
