

# Arizona COVID-19 Guidance

## 'Release from Quarantine & Isolation' Flow Chart

Has the patient **tested POSITIVE** for **COVID-19**?

**YES**

**ISOLATE for 5 DAYS**

**SYMPTOMS**

**Symptoms NOT resolving after 5 days**

**Remain at home until your fever has resolved for 24 hours.**

*Continue to wear mask around others for 5 DAYS*

**Symptoms resolving after 5 days**

**Able to LEAVE house & Continue to wear mask around others for 5 DAYS**

**NO SYMPTOMS**

Has the patient been **EXPOSED** to someone who **tested POSITIVE** for **COVID-19**?

**YES**

**FULLY VACCINATED\***

**OR**

**PARTIALLY VACCINATED\*\* or NOT VACCINATED**

**NO QUARANTINE**

- **WEAR A MASK** around others for 10 days
- **TEST** on day 5, if possible

*If you develop symptoms, get tested and stay home.*

**QUARANTINE**

- **Stay home for 5 days & wear a mask around others for 5 additional days**
- **TEST** on day 5, if possible

*If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home.*

**If you CANNOT quarantine you must wear a mask for 10 days.**

*\*Fully vaccinated: Completion of a 2-dose series within 6 months; OR completion of a single-dose series within 2 months; OR completion of primary series AND received a booster dose.*

*\*\*Partially vaccinated: Primary series not completed; OR primary series completed, but NOT boosted (2 months after 1-dose series, 6 months after 2-dose series).*

## **SFX Covid-19 Isolation and Quarantine Guidelines (Beginning January 4, 2022):**

*Scenario 1: If you are exposed to someone who tests positive for COVID-19 and you:*

- Have received a Covid-19 booster; OR
- Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last six months; OR
- Completed the primary series of Johnson & Johnson vaccine within the last two months;

*Student/Staff member will need to:*

- Wear a mask indoors on campus for ten days following the exposure.
- Recommended that you get tested on day five following the exposure with a PCR or antigen test.

\*\* If symptoms develop at any time, you should get tested for Covid-19 and remain home.

*Scenario 2: If you are a close contact to someone with Covid-19 and you:*

- Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over six months ago and are not boosted; OR
- Completed the primary series of Johnson & Johnson vaccine over two months ago and are not boosted; OR
- Are unvaccinated;

*Student/Staff member will need to:*

- Stay out of school for five calendar days. After that, student/staff member will be required to wear a mask while indoors for the next five calendar days.
- Recommended that you get tested on day five following the exposure.

\*\* If symptoms develop at any time, you should get tested for Covid-19 and remain home.

*Scenario 3: If a student or staff members tests positive for Covid-19 (regardless of vaccination status):*

- Isolate at home for five days from the day symptoms started. If asymptomatic, isolate at home for five days from the date the test was conducted.
- After isolating at home for five days, the student or staff member may return to school if the student/staff member does not develop symptoms or symptoms are resolving.
- After returning to school:
  - A well-fitting mask must be worn indoors for the next five calendar days.

***Please note that anyone on campus displaying Covid-like illness or symptoms will be sent home immediately and will need to remain off campus for five days. Continuing to keep our student body and faculty/staff safe and healthy is a top priority. We want to ensure we are able to continue to experience minimal to no disruptions to our school year to keep students learning in person.***
